We bless you with the spirit and inspiration of the Apostleship, that it may be and abide with you from this very moment, that you may realize and appreciate the wonderful blessing that has come to you from God and utilize all of your ability and strength and power in laboring to magnify this calling, and to bring souls to a knowledge of the truth.

We bless you, dear brother, for your past integrity and devotion to the Lord, for your services as a missionary; and we say unto you that every desire of your heart in righteousness and every gift, grace, and endowment that may be necessary for you to possess to fully fulfil the duties and the obligations of this high and holy calling, the apostleship of the Lord Jesus Christ, shall be given to you, through your faith and your faithfulness; and we bless you that you may be strengthened in body and in mind, and that you may be renewed, figuratively speaking, in your youth, that you may, although advanced in years, have such health and vigor of body and of mind that you shall enjoy these labors, even as much as though you were a younger man.

These blessings, together with every other blessing that it is necessary for you to receive, we bestow upon you, not in our own name or authority, but in the name of Jesus Christ and in the authority of God which we hold — the holy Melchizedek Priesthood — even so, Amen.
