NOTE: The phrase "GRACE AND TRUTH" and "LIGHT AND TRUTH" both refer to the Saviour in the beginning, yet in that context the words "grace" and "light" never appear together, as for instance, "GRACE AND LIGHT AND TRUTH." This may suggest that to put them together might be a redundancy, suggesting that grace and light might be the same thing.

v.10 Making request, if by any means now at length I might have a prosperous journey by the will of God to come unto you.
