Mar. 1 & 15, 1842 the Book of Abraham published in the Times and Seasons organization of the Female Relief Society March 17, 1842 May 4, 1842 Joseph gave James Adams, Hyrum Smith, Newel K. Whitney, George Miller, Brigham Young, Heber C. Kimball and Willard Richards their endowments. August 6, 1842 Joseph prophesied that the Saints would be driven to the Rocky Mountains July 12, 1843 revelation on celestial marriage was written (D&C 132) October 9, 1843 missionaries sail for the Pacific Islands. January 29, 1844 Joseph nominated for Presidency of the United States Mar. 11, 1844 Council of Fifty organized 20,000 attend conference at Nauvoo - Joseph said the whole of North and April 5 - 7, 1844 South America is Zion. This was the last general conference which Joseph attended. During the conference the Prophet delivered his famous King Follett funeral sermon, the greatest cosmological sermon ever taught by the Prophet. It went back to before "the beginning" when "God himself was once as we are now, and is an exalted man, and sits enthroned in yonder heavens!" The Prophet said, "You have got to learn how to be gods yourselves, and to be kings and priests to God, the same as all gods have done before you, namely, by going from one small degree to another." June 16, 1844 Joseph delivered the last sermon of his lifetime. Joseph told them of his love for them and gave them a key to understanding the depth of their own religion. He told them about the nature of the Godhead, observing that the Hebrew word *Elohim* is plural, that it is the proper name of God the Father, and that the word may also refer to the members of the pre-mortal

Council of gods.

June 27, 1844 Joseph and Hyrum murdered at Carthage jail.
