Sode experiences of all the prophets, LeGrand Baker

In Amos' testimony, "Surely the Lord God will do nothing, but he revealeth his secret unto his servants the prophets." (Amos 3:7) The word translated "secret" is SOD which means the decisions of the Council in Heaven. Isaiah 6 is just one example of an account of a prophet's receiving a vision of his own experiences at the Council, and thus re-receiving the instructions he first received there. There are many such accounts in the scriptures. Some, like Isaiah's are quite detailed, others contain only a hint of the full story. The following is a partial list of the prophets who report having had a SOD experience.
